MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION BETWEEN MOEJ AND MOEF ON ENVIRONMENTAL COOPERATION

OBJECTIVE

To strengthen, facilitate and develop mutual cooperation in the field of environment.

AREAS OF COOPERATION

1. **Pollution Control (Air, Land and Water);**
2. Marine Pollution Control;
3. Climate Change particularly in strengthening policy frameworks; Inventory, Monitoring, Reporting, and Verification of Green House Gases; and Adaptation related Disaster Risk Management;
4. Hazardous Substances Management;
5. Solid Waste (including Environmentally Sustainable Cities) and Hazardous Waste Management;
6. Development of Ecotourism;
7. Environmental Technology;
8. Peatland Management;
9. Sustainable Lake Management; and
10. Law Enforcement (forensic technology).

FORMS OF COOPERATION

Dialogue and partnership, Exchanging information, Capacity Building and Pilot projects, etc.

DURATION

4 years from 10 April, 2017

Framework for cooperation between MOEJ and MOEF

Mutual Agreement

The Ministry of Environment and Forestry of the Republic of Indonesia (KLHK)



Three activities (WEPA, Technical assistance, Intercity cooperation) will be included under bilateral cooperation framework.



【WEPA】

- Implementation of an action program on water improvement of Citarum River compiled by KLHK will be supported.
- Creating a list of pollution load and implementing effective effluent regulations at high pollution load area.
- Workshops for Indonesian local governments to introduce appropriate technology, and share knowledge and/or know-how of enforcement and implementation of regulations including total daily load regulations

Target: Bandung district, etc.

【Technical assistance】

- Study of appropriate wastewater treatment technology for local textile industries will be conducted.
- The results of the study will be shared among stakeholders in Citarum River Basin, so that the application of demonstrated technology is considered by Indonesian side for wastewater gathering treatment facilities in industrial area and/or small-middle size industrial factories.

Target: Cimahi city, etc.

【Intercity cooperation】

- Capacity building for Indonesian local governments such as training and lecture by Japanese local governments will be conducted.
- A support of formulating a master plan for water quality management through understanding actual conditions of wastewater management in Citarum River Basin will be supported.
 - Know-how, knowledge and experiences will be shared in joint committee among Indonesian local governments in Citarum River Basin.

Target: Bandung city, Kawasaki city, etc.

Proper waste management, including waste to energy being promoted under the Japan – Indonesia Joint Committee Meeting on Ministry of the Environment Waste to Energy, contributes to improve the water quality of Citarum River.
