

**Ministry of Environment and Water** is responsible for environmental protection, including water quality management. They integrate the functions of water resources and water services, strengthen the management of the country's water ecosystem, and ensure adequate and sustainable water resources and supplies.

**Ministry of Health** regulates the quality of drinking water.

**National Water Commission** regulates the entities involved in water supply and sewerage services under the Water Services Industry Act 2006 (Act 655).

**Local Government** are involved in water resources planning and development.
